- **Public Hearing – Sewer Rate Increase:** Council to hold a public hearing for the purpose of hearing public comments and testimony regarding amending sanitary sewer monthly base fees in the City of Troy, and to explain the reasons for such action.
- **Resolution #2025-002:** A resolution of the city of Troy adopting amendments to the sewer monthly base fee and providing for an effective date.
- **Year-End Financials:** Greg Mann to present the City of Troy's year-end financial report.
- **Reimbursement request:** Theresa Wardle requests approval from the council for reimbursement for the Pickleball rebounder boards purchased for Eli Stoner's Senior Project in the amount of \$2737.70. The Troy Rec district approved the grant in that amount payable to the City. Proof of payment by Theresa Wardle has been obtained.
- **Troy Arts Council:** Council to review and take action on the TAC2025 Summer Musical Budget and to discuss future processes and procedures for working with vendors and/or volunteers to ensure legal compliance.
- **Irrigation Ordinance:** Council to discuss a Water Conservation/Irrigation Ordinance and possibly set a public hearing date for adoption.
- **Code Enf./Law Enf. Needs:** City Council will discuss whether to hire a new Code Enforcement Officer or consider the possibility of hiring a City Police Officer in the future. Retired Moscow Police Chief James Fry will be present to provide insight, guidance, and recommendations to help inform.
